Important Reminders

- Annual HOA Dues Reminder: As most of you are aware the Sun Valley HOA is a community whose operation costs are funded through yearly assessments attached to each home in Sun Valley. Upon purchasing your home and signing your paperwork you have agreed to abide by the HOA covenants and pay your yearly assessment. If, at any time you fail to render your yearly assessment as required, the operating budget can quickly slide into an operating deficit that can carry over requiring the HOA to make other adjustments to balance the budget. For example, are you aware that the street lights in the community are paid from HOA assessments? If you are having difficulties in paying your yearly assessments, please send an email to <u>svboardmembers@sunvalleyhoa.org</u>. We're willing to work with you on establishing a payment plan.
- Failure to pay assessments in a timely manner also has serious consequences for the homeowner who will be assessed a monthly \$25 late fee to all delinquent accounts. Late fees can quickly add up. Please note that the Board is in the process of placing all past due HOA unpaid balances in collections. Any court and attorney costs will be added to the late assessments and will have to be paid by the homeowner.
